## **Important Dates:**

In Person Absentee voting begins September 21st

Registration deadline is Oct 15th for the November general election.

Last date to request mail in absentee ballots is Oct 30<sup>th</sup> (must be received by 5:00 pm)

Last date to vote absentee in person is Nov 3rd

Election day Nov 6th polls open from 6:00 am to 7:00 pm

Notes (in no particular order)

Anyone who has had their rights restored must re-register. Not all people whose rights have been automatically restored have been notified. Having paid restitution or other financial conditions are no longer necessary for having rights restored.

Absentee voting may be in person or by mail. There are many acceptable reasons.

Curbside voting is also an option for handicapped persons

Encourage anyone needing a photo ID: go to the registrar's office for photo ID -- no documentation or fee

To register online the person must have a DMV ID number

Anyone who has not voted since 2012 should check their status. They may have been placed on inactive status.

Voter applications must have residential and mailing address if different. Not having a current mailing address is a potential factor for being purged.
