Vote Early In Person (Bring ID)

Saturday, October 30 is the last day to vote early in person before Election Day at the Lancaster County Voter Registration Office, 8311 Mary Ball Road, Lancaster, **8:30 AM - 4:30 PM, Monday - Friday and Saturday, October 23 & 30.**

Vote By Mail

Return witnessed ballot:

By mail postmarked by Nov. 2 and received by noon Nov. 5
Deliver to Lancaster County Voter Registration Office by Election Day
Deliver to your polling place on Election Day, November 2

Vote In Person On Election Day (Bring ID)

On Tuesday, November 2, 2021, Election Day polls are open 6 AM until 7 PM. See voting precincts in attached article.



Your Last Chance To Vote

The last day for in-person early voting at your county Voter Registration Office is Saturday, October 30, 2021. In Lancaster County, the Voter Registration Office, located at 8311 Mary Ball Road, Lancaster, VA, is open 8:30 A.M. to 4:30 p.m.

The last day to vote in-person at your voting place is Election Day, November 2, 2021, from 6:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. You must vote in the District where you live. Polling places are: **District 1**, Upper Lancaster Volunteer Fire Department, 5170 Mary Ball Road, Lively; **District 2**, Trinity Episcopal Church, 8484 Mary Ball Road, Lancaster; **District 301**, White Stone Baptist Church, 517 Chesapeake Drive, White Stone; **District 302**, Kilmarnock Baptist Church, 65 East Church Street, Kilmarnock; **District 4**, Grace Episcopal Church, 303 South Main Street, Kilmarnock; and **District 5**, Irvington Baptist Church, 53 King Carter Drive, Irvington.

If you are not sure of your polling place, you can go online to Polling Place Lookup, at <https://www.elections.virginia.gov> or call your county Voter Registration Office in Lancaster County, at 804-462-5228.

If you are voting by mail, remember that a witness signature is required on all mail-in ballots cast in the November 2, 2021 elections. If a ballot is missing a witness signature, the voter will be contacted within three days of receipt by the local voter registration office and asked to correct it. The ballot must be corrected by noon, on Friday, November 5, in order to be counted.

You can submit your completed and witnessed mail-in ballot by mail, postmarked on or before November 2 and received by noon on Friday, November 5. Or, you can hand deliver your mail-in ballot to your county Voter Registration Office or your polling place by Election Day, November 2.

Voters may provide either an acceptable form of ID or sign an ID confirmation statement at the polls. Acceptable IDs are Virginia driver's license (current or expired), valid DMV-issued ID, valid employee ID with photograph, U.S. Military ID, valid student ID, valid U.S. passport, government issued ID, voter ID from Department of Elections, voter confirmation documents, tribal ID, nursing home ID, current utility bill, government check or paycheck containing name and address of voter, any current document containing the name and address of the voter.

- To your polling place on Election Day


